GUIDELINES FOR TOURNAMENT KATA:

Students can perform Any Kata except those listed below which are for
BLACK BELTS ONLY:

KORYO, O DAN, KEUMGANG, TAEBACK, PYONGWON, SUNGKIDO,
HORWANG, HANHUSON, MPA

TOURNAMENT RULES

All events will be held in the same ring

HAND FORMS

1. All events will be judged by a maximum of 5 judges or a minimum of 3 judges.
 2. All forms will be judged on: Good stances; power(strong kicks & stances); knowledge of form; flow & focus.
 3. Scores will range from a minimum of 4.0 to a maximum of 8.0
 4. A competitor will be able to restart his or her form with a ½ point deduction.
 5. Scores will be determined by dropping the high or low score, then adding the remaining scores.
In the event of a tie for 1st, 2nd or 3rd place, the LOW SCORE will be added in. If the score is still tied, The HIGH SCORE will be added in.

WEAPON FORMS

1. The same scoring procedure applies for weapons as for hand forms.
 2. Weapons will be judged on :
Control of the weapon; power; flow & focus; technique & balance.
 3. 1 point will be deducted from the competitors score for a dropped weapon.
 4. ½ point will be deducted if you hit yourself with a weapon.

BREAKING

1. Maximum of 3 breaking stations per competitor.
 2. Wood breaks ONLY for all competitors.
1st miss AUTOMATIC 1 POINT DEDUCTION
2nd miss AUTOMATIC ADDITIONAL ½ POINT DEDUCTION
3rd miss AUTOMATIC ADDITIONAL ½ POINT DEDUCTION RESULTING IN A TOTAL DEDUCTION OF 2 POINTS
 3. Judging will be on: Focus, technique; degree of difficulty; breaking wood on first attempt.
 4. Holders should be available and breaking routines rehearsed before entering the ring. **Parents may hold for competitors*
TO AVOID MULTIPLE TIES OFFICIALS WILL COUNT EACH SUCCESSFUL BROKEN PIECE OF WOOD TOWARD SCORE.

SSIREUM

The object is to push the opponent out of the ring; to make them touch the floor with their body; hand; knee; etc.
Participants must wear their Belts and MUST HAVE OWN HEAD GEAR.
BOYS AND GIRLS WILL COMPETE SEPARATELY FROM AGES 8 TO ADULT.

SPARRING

BOYS AND GIRLS WILL COMPETE SEPARATELY IN SPARRING FROM AGES 8 TO ADULT.
Protective hand, foot & headgear is required for sparring. If contestant has no gear, it will be provided at the tournament.
Each match will be (1) minute in length. ADULTS will be a minute and a half (1 ½).
Time will run continuously unless stopped by the Head Referee.
Light to no contact! Excessive contact—Warning given 1st time; 2nd time loss of match(disqualification)

POINT AREAS--SPARRING

WHITE to NAVY BELTS

1. Side of head(NO front of face)
2. Chest
3. Stomach
4. Side of body

PURPLE to BLACK BELTS

1. Top, side and back of head
2. Chest
3. Stomach
4. Side of body.

ACCEPTABLE TECHNIQUES

1. Any kick to acceptable target area
2. Reverse punch or jab; punch with either hand to body
3. Hammer fist; reverse chop to acceptable area
4. Back fist to acceptable head area ONLY
5. Back fist to body.

UNACCEPTABLE TECHNIQUES

1. Contact to face, groin or joints
2. Excessive contact to body
3. Kicking or punching to back
4. Blind spinning techniques
5. Running out of Ring
6. Grabbing or pushing

DISQUALIFICATION

1. Uncontrolled techniques
2. Injury to opponent
3. Loss of temper or bad sportsmanship
4. Disrespect to JUDGES
5. Mark left on an opponent

Excessive/Aggressive contact or bleeding as a result of contact will result in IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION . All other infractions of the rules will receive ONE (1) warning. In the event of a SECOND (2) warning, a point (1) will be awarded to the opponent. A THIRD (3) warning will result in DISQUALIFICATION.
